

DHS Nonconfirmations

When an employee receives a 'DHS tentative nonconfirmation' result in the E-Verify system, this status will appear in the "current status" column in the "Top Pending E-Verify Actions" view on your dashboard. Please tell that employee to contact the International Employment office immediately, so that we can assist him/her in handling this issue as quickly as possible. International Employment will handle all parts of the process with the employee, including providing the tentative nonconfirmation and referral notices to the employee, and calling the DHS number with the employee to get the DHS tentative nonconfirmation resolved.

You will not need to click on anything else in the I-9 Guardian system once you see this result; International Employment will take over from there, and we will go through the next steps in the system with the employee.
